It teaches children to be inclusive and compassionate.</p>	 <p>A fictional story with activities and ideas to talk about, with a wordless storyboard that encourages children to tell another story, supporting children's personal, social and emotional development.</p>	 <p>This book helps children develop their forgiveness skills and learn how to accept an apology and move on without holding grudges. At the same time, encourage children to let go of disappointment and to accept when things don't go the way they hope.</p>	 <p>A story about learning to respect other people's viewpoints. Two monsters on either side of a mountain, argue about whether day or night is departing or arriving. They throw rocks and destroy their mountain arguing until they are able to respect each other's point of view and live peacefully together.</p>	<p>Class teacher will choose additional bible stories to share with the class and revisit prior values and texts to ensure learning is embedded.</p>
